Through the generosity of the Friends of the Butler Library, the popular on-demand film streaming service Kanopy is now available for free at the Butler Library. Library card holders can access Kanopy and sign up to start streaming films instantly by visiting <https://butlerlibrary.kanopy.com/frontpage> or by clicking the link to Kanopy under the "Quick Links" tab. Films can be streamed from any computer, television, mobile device or platform by downloading the Kanopy app for iOS, Android, AppleTV, Chromecast or Roku. For best viewing experience, we recommend downloading the app onto your viewing device or devices. There are links to the apps at the bottom of the Kanopy front page.

Kanopy showcases more than 30,000 of the world's best films, including award-winning documentaries, rare and hard-to-find titles, film festival favorites, indie and classic films, and world cinema with collections from Kino Lorber, Music Box Films, Samuel Goldwyn, The Orchard, The Great Courses, PBS and thousands of independent filmmakers. Kanopy provides Butler Library patrons with access to films of unique social and cultural value; films that are often difficult or impossible to access elsewhere, and programming that features diversity, with a wide array of foreign language films and films on race, and current affairs.

The Kanopy collection includes indie hits like "Hunt For the Wilderpeople" and "2 Days in Paris," classic masterpieces like "Aguirre, the Wrath of God" and "Seven Samurai," and award-winning documentaries like the 2017 Oscar®-nominated "I Am Not Your Negro" and Sundance Film Festival winner "Mother of George." New@The Library: Tote Bags full of information on Health Topics

Getting vetted, reliable, and current information on a health topic is often not easy. Searching the Internet for material on a health topic often leaves you overwhelmed by the amount of that information and not in a position to determine which sites contain trustworthy information.

To address the problem of finding reliable and current information, the Butler Public Library and the Atlantic Health Systems Libraries in Morris and Union Counties are pleased to announce their partnership in making reliable and up-to-date information on health topics available to Butler residents. The Atlantic Health Systems Libraries have given the Butler Public Library six tote bags with materials on various health topics. A Butler Library patron can borrow the tote bag for three weeks to read the materials in a bag. Some of the materials are to be returned to the Library, while others can be kept by the patron for future reference. Funding from the Atlantic Health Systems Libraries allows for replenishing the materials to be kept by patrons.

For now, the Library has tote bags on these topics but it expects to get bags on other health topics as well.
